Christ Church Full-time Music Minister

General Responsibilities

The Music Minister of Christ Church, (1) will oversee all music ministries and programs of the church; (2) supervise and instruct the church's music direction & musicians; (3) develop ways to improve the church's music programs and the congregation's musical skills; (4) coordinate the church's music programs with New Saint Andrews College and other Christian music ministries in Moscow; and (5) develop new or expanded musical opportunities as part of the church's outreach and service to the local community and to congregations of the CREC.

Specific Responsibilities

Musical Leadership

- Oversee Christ Church's music programs and personnel, working closely with the church ministers and elders.
- Provide musical leadership for congregational singing, choirs, and orchestra.
- Work under the oversight of the senior minister to select music for the weekly services.
- Select music and prepare the Christ Church Choir and Orchestra for meditations before the service on average 3 out of 4 Sundays.
- Provide musical leadership at all major church-sponsored events and conferences.

Musical Assessment

• Develop a means of evaluating the musical skills and resources, liturgical music practices and potential of the average parishioner of Christ Church and present a written report to the Christ Church Elders on an annual basis.

Musical Instruction

- Provide congregational singing and musical instruction, as needed and appropriate (i.e. hymn lessons).
- Lead periodic Psalm/Hymn Sings.
- Develop and promote musical literacy through the use of various media.

Qualifications

Spiritual Qualifications

• Meets the requirements for an elder as listed in Titus 1:5-9 and 1 Timothy 3:1-7

- Able to maintain a cheerful, hard-working work ethic with the Christ Church staff and elders.
- As able, participate in elder visits, and assist in pastoral counseling if such a gifting is evident.
- Be accountable to the elders of Christ Church, and report to the Senior Minister.

Academic Qualifications

- Graduate degree in a musical field (doctorate preferred).
- Gifts in leading both choral and orchestral groups.
- Familiarity with the Cantus Christi is preferred, but not necessary.

Theological Qualifications

- Be theologically qualified in the CREC (i.e. affirmation of the ancient Christian creeds, and affirmation of the Westminster Confession of Faith).
- Familiarity with and appreciation for the Reformed tradition of musical worship, Psalm singing, and Covenant renewal liturgy.

Compensation

Christ Church will offer a full-time salary plus benefits based on qualification & experience.
